Complete at least 50 hours of volunteer service at A Precious Child. Time spent during YSL activities (meetings, fundraisers) count towards volunteer requirements.
Organize at least one donation drive to collect high-need items (clothing, hygiene products, school supplies, etc.) to benefit the children and families we serve.
Facilitate at least one awareness activity in your community to share information about A Precious Child and ways for supporters to get involved.
Secure at least one sponsor to benefit our annual Movie Night fundraiser and market the event to bolster ticket sales.
